The Transbay Project consists of building a new multi-modal Transit Center on the site of the former Transbay Terminal in downtown San Francisco, the extension of rail service from 4th and King Streets underground into the new Transit Center, and a redevelopment area surrounding the new Transit Center. Featuring intercity, regional, and local buses along with commuter and future high speed rail, the project will ultimately connect 11 different public transit systems and return the San Francisco Bay Area and the State to a culture of mass transit.
